Xtra Math

We are using a program called XtraMath to increase speed and accuracy in arithmetic. Students are encouraged to practice a few minutes each day on a computer, tablet or phone. Your child was sent home with a note on how to sign up and get your child practicing!

Reading Logs

Be sure your child is continuing to fill in their reading log each night they read for 20 or more minutes. Neatness and effort is expected when completing these logs. The reading log is due on Monday with a parent and child signature. Look for a new log to home that day as well.

Timed Multiplication Test

Each Wednesday, your child will be taking timed multiplication tests in order to practice and assess their basic fact fluency. Knowing basic multiplication facts quickly and accurately is essential for understanding the harder fourth grade math concepts. You can help your child by using flash cards or using Xtra math at home. These tests are not graded, however, your child will be recognized when they pass all their basic facts within 8 minutes. Look for an example of the test in your child's red homework folder.
